

Hawaii

The Hawaiian Islands were annexed by the United States in 1898. Hawaii became a territory in 1900 and a state in 1959. One of the islands is also named "Hawaii." The state capital is Honolulu, which is on the island of Oahu.

The state consists of five counties: HAWAII (island of Hawaii), HONOLULU (principally the island of Oahu), KALAWAO (part of the island of Molokai), KAUAI (the islands of Kauai and Niihau) and MAUI (the islands of Maui, Lanai, and most of Molokai). Entries are arranged by island. The index of cities, at the right, gives the name of the island for each city.
