**CASE HISTORIES:** A NATURAL MOTHER GAVE BIRTH IN 1960 AT THE SALVATION ARMY HOME, BUT DOESN'T KNOW WHICH ADOPTION AGENCY TOOK CUSTODY OF HER BABY. THE SAME PROBLEM OCCURS FOR A NATURAL MOTHER WHO GAVE BIRTH IN 1958 AT BOOTH MEMORIAL HOME. AN ADOPTEE WAS BORN IN 1928 AT THE SALVATION ARMY HOME AND WAS PLACED BY THE CHILDREN'S HOME FINDING AND AID SOCIETY OF IDAHO.
