The American Adoption Congress consists of autonomous groups and individuals who wish to establish a network to effectively change the present structure in adoption. There will be a national conference in Washington D.C. May 4-7, 1979.

The Bellevue Hotel has set aside ten double and thirty-eight quad rooms for our use. Reservations will be made on a first come, first served basis by completing the registration form and sending the required amount by check made payable to the American Adoption Congress. Meal tickets may be purchased now. Those not wishing to stay at the Bellevue may purchase meal tickets. The price might increase between now and May, so as adjustment may be necessary when you register at the conference. The prices quoted on the registration form include the 8% sales tax.

A fee of \$25.00 for registration is being charged to cover the costs of printing, postage, meeting room rental, and other administrative costs. This price will increase for those who do not register before April 20.

On Saturday night May 5 a banquet will be held at a large Washington restaurant. A dinner, guest speaker and entertainment is being planned. The cost will be \$15.00 per person.

Adopted persons 21 and older would be allowed to inspect their birth certificate and other now-closed public records under terms of a controversial bill prepared by State Sen. John Sinks, R-Fort Wayne.

Two Allen County women - Martha Barrow of New Haven and Roberta Adamonis of Fort Wayne - requested the legislation, and a Senate committee is expected to review the proposal in coming weeks.

Barrow is president and founder of Search for Tomorrow Inc., a group of more than 100 adopted persons seeking to obtain information about their natural parents. Adamonis is the organization's secretary.

Sinks reported that con-

cern about possible hereditary diseases motivated him to sponsor the measure, even though he expects criticism from some adoptive parents who don't want their children to discover the identities of their natural parents.

It also is anticipated the bill will be criticized as a step that discourages people from adopting children.

According to Sinks, an Elmhurst High School guidance counselor, adopted persons can expect birth certificates and other records now only at the direction of an Indiana judge.

Marriage licenses, deed transfers and other public records are open to inspection, and birth certificates for adopted persons should be no exception, Sinks declared.

"I'm not trying to be

snoopy," he said. "I just believe adopted persons have a right to this information."

Adamonis, a 30-year-old housewife, said adopted persons often want to obtain medical histories about their natural parents to know what diseases they may be susceptible to and what diseases they could pass on to their own children.

Adamonis, who was adopted at age 13, knows the identities of her natural parents, but said that many other adopted persons do not. She claimed adopted persons experience a deep need within themselves to know more about their parents, and if that need is not fulfilled, they can suffer damaging psychological problems.
